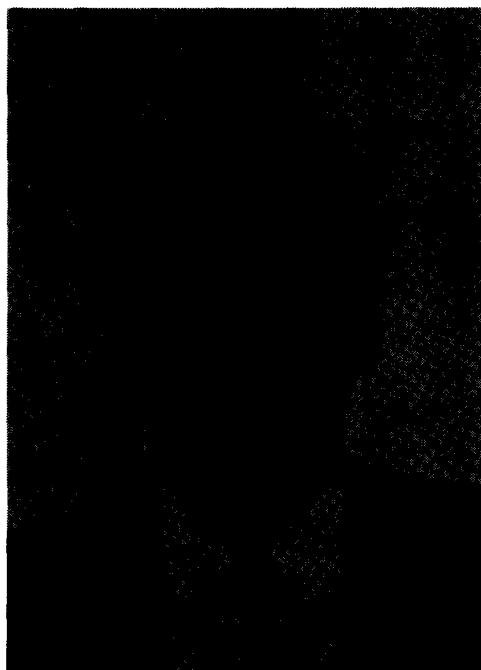


Introducing new Council members . . .
