Tailings Management Handbook: A Life-Cycle Approach / Edited by Kimberly Finke Morrison

As long as there is mining and mineral processing, tailings and the responsible management thereof will remain at the forefront with a company's environmental, social, and governance (ESG) performance, in part, a reflection of how well tailings risks are being managed.

The Global Industry Standard on Tailings Management (GISTM) aims to prevent failure of tailings facilities by providing operators with specified measures and approaches throughout the mine life cycle, considering multiple stakeholder perspectives. In 2021, the International Council on Mining & Metals (ICMM) published the *Tailings Management: Good Practice Guide* intended to support safe, responsible management of tailings across the global mining industry.

The <u>Tailings Management Handbook</u> is a comprehensive resource with contributions from more than 100 world-renowned experts; the handbook focuses on the basics, life-cycle planning, site and tailings characterization, TSF design and construction, as well as systems and operations of TSFs. The inclusion of 42 case studies is an added plus with real-world successes and lessons learned.
